



**Declaration of Intent of
Neighbouring Countries Economic Development Cooperation Agency
(Public Organization) on Organization Management**

According to National Anti-corruption Strategy Phase 3 (2017-2021) that has stated its vision as “Zero Tolerance & Clean Thailand” and its mission to create a culture which does not tolerate corruption, to enhance good governance in integrative administration of the country, and to reform the entire anti-corruption regime to equal the international standards, which are in compliance with Neighbouring Countries Economic Development Cooperation Agency’s (Public Organization) (NEDA) organization management policy. NEDA’s executives, officials, and staff have collective will to abide honesty, virtue, transparency, and anti-corruption principles. NEDA’s transparent organization management policy and honest officials are for common and national benefit.

In this regard, NEDA has made a Declaration of Intent of NEDA on Organization Management, aiming at executives, officials, and staff’s operation to comply with following aspects;

1. Transparency: the Organization’s information and operation are disclosed clearly, correctly, up-to-date, easily accessible, and able to be examined.
2. Accountability: the Organization’s operation is in line with good governance principles, liability, and responsibility to achieve its goals with public trust.
3. Anti-corruption: the Organization creates anti-corruption culture and is against the act that leads to conflict of interest. The punishment is set for those who do not comply.
4. Virtue Culture: The Organization encourages its executives, officials, and staff to cherish the virtue culture and work against the conflict of interest.
5. Morality: The Organization promotes moral, equality, and non-discrimination internally, appropriate incentive for officials is provided. Budget management is transparent, worthwhile, and examinable.
