

Objectives of the Project

TheHighway Route No. 304 from km. 191+860.000 to km. 195+310.000 (existing km. 26 to km. 29) and approx. km. 207+760 to km.223+269. (existing km. 42 to km. 57) which are in Prachinburi and Nakhon Ratchasima is two-lane two-direction traffic highway and have caused bottlenecks while the other portion of this route had ben expanded to have four lanes-two direction traffic, and there are large numbers of accidents in each year. This route has to support the increasing traffic volume and be the route that pass through Donphayayen–Khaoyai forest areas in Khaoyai NationalPark and Tublan National Park. These areas have been performing as the wildlife corridors for developing ecology system of the forest.

Department of Highways has realized the importance of highway development based on nature conservation. In 2558 to 2561 B.E. fiscal year, Department of Highways started both the expansion of the Highway Route No. 304 and construction of the wildlife corridor project together(approx.km.191+860.000 to 195.465.000 and approx. km.207+760 to km.223+269) for expand two-way traffic to four-way traffic totally approx. 19 km. long to

reduce the numbers of accidents, support the increasing traffic and become the Khaoyai and Tublan National Park corridors. The project can help protecting valuable bio-diversity of Dong Pha Ya Yen and Khaoyai Forest, the World Heritage Site.

The Project has been divided into 3 Construction Contracts as follows.

- 1. A. Kabinburi to A. Paktongchai (Wildlife Corridor) Project
- 2. A. Kabinburi to A. Wangnomkhiao (Section 3 Part 1) Project
- 3. A. Kabinburi to A. Wangnomkhiao (Section 3 Part 2) Project

The details of each contract are shown in the table


Prime Objectives;

- 4. Develop theknowledge of wildlife corridor for apply to other roadway construction that will pass through preserve areas.






Project Location (map) on Highway Route 304

Cut & Cover tunnel cross section wildlife overpass Approx. KM. 194+600 – KM. 194+900






Elevated Structure cross section for Wildlife Underpass About KM, 193+500, KM, 208+800 and KM, 217+000
